#### **WELCOME TO CAMP**

Welcome to the fifth year of Next Level Kidz Summer Camps!

Each week, Next Level Kidz will offer three specialty camp options for campers to choose from. These camps will provide a general overview and introduction into that STEAM or Sports activity. Each day, campers will participate in their STEAM or Sports Specialty Camp instruction from 9am-12pm\*. For the remainder of the afternoon (12-4pm)\*, campers will be split into groups by age and will enjoy traditional camp activities, such as field games, arts & crafts, group competitions, etc.

\*Before and After Care are available each day from 7:30am-9am and 4-6pm, for an additional charge.



# REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Registration for all camps can be done online at FortMill.NextLevelKidz.com. If you are logging onto the website for the first time, you will need to set up a new account to access the parent portal. If you already have an account with Next Level Kidz, you can register by logging onto your parent portal at the same web address listed above.

All camps require a \$50 non-refundable deposit at the time of registration per week of camp, per child. Payment must be made by credit card. If you need to use another form of payment, please email info@nextlevelkidz.com.

Full, online payment for each week of camp is due two Fridays prior to the start of the camp week for which your child(ren) is registered. Failure to submit payment will result in your child being removed from their week of camp.

Any transfers between camps done at least two weeks prior to the camp start date will be allowed, pending camp availability. The \$50 deposit will transfer to the new camp. Transfers done less than two weeks in advance will lose their \$50 deposit per week, per child.

All camps have a \$50 non-refundable deposit per week, per child. Cancellations made less than 14 days prior will be responsible for the full camp payment.

#### **WHAT TO BRING**

Campers enrolled in a Sports Specialty Camp will spend the majority of their day in outdoor activities.

- Must apply sunscreen prior to camp
- Bring a reusable water bottle
- Wear sports cleats (metal cleats are not allowed)
- Bring a pair of tennis shoes for afternoon activities
- Wear light clothing and a baseball cap (optional)
- See each sport camp for additional equipment needed, if any

Campers enrolled in a STEAM Specialty Camp will spend their day evenly between indoor and outdoor activities.

Ensure all belongings are marked with the camper's name. Campers are not allowed to bring electronics to camp.



#### **BRIGHTWHEEL**

In order to provide a safe check in/out experience, provide our staff with access to emergency information and to communicate with parents, we have partnered with Brightwheel.

Upon registration, you will be sent an email by Brightwheel where you will be able to complete your family's profile prior to your child's first day of camp. Clicking the link inside this email will prompt you to create an account and add all of your important information such as emergency contacts, allergies, medications, authorized pick-ups, and more.

Once completed, you can also access your account via the Brightwheel app on your Android or iPhone. You will also recieve a 4-Digit pin on your mobile device in the app. This 4-Digit pin will be used to check your child in and out of camp programming.
